STANDARD RULES REGARDING LICENSE & TRAINING

- All participants must have insurance, which must be shown at registration to joining our class if requested to do so.
- Shojujitsu Karate Do Association (SKDA/VBR SK) cannot accept responsibility for any loss, theft or damage of personal items during training.
- It is the practitioner's own or parent's responsibility to look after their belongings during training.
- A temporary licence/insurance certificate may be issued to students awaiting their license if they requested a renewal.
- All cheques should be made payable to "VBR SK".

Subsistence:

It is strongly recommended that all students bring water with them for every training session.

GENERAL TRAINING

All students are requested to respect the dress code that we adhere to during training.

- o No watches or bracelets (except medic-bracelets).
- o Good hygiene is essential.
- o No hats; No jewellery, including rings; No external piercing.
- o No outdoor shoes are permitted in the dojo. Zori, clean tabi or bare feet are the only options.
- o Please make yourself presentable for each session (clean/tidy gi or hakama ± tabi)
- o Ladies/girls are expected to wear a t-shirt under the gi
- o Chest and groin guards are permissible and, indeed, recommended.

OUTDOOR TRAINING

* The clothing that is permitted for outdoor training is dependent on what form of training is being undertaken and what the instructor(s) wish to achieve through that form of training. It is best to check with the senior instructor before attending such a session.

- o Tabi or training shoes may or may not* be permitted if the ground is rough or unusual.
- o Waterproof clothing may or may not* be permitted if it is wet outside.
- o Fleece or warm clothing may or may not* be permitted if it is cold outside
